Dear Lector,


Winter once again was very brief, and as we prepare for the beginning of Lent, I am sending with this letter the spring Lector schedule, covering the period March 11–June 4.

New Lectors. We welcome four new Lectors on this schedule. Laurel Jentgen will serve at 6:30 PM and 5:00 PM Sunday, Kyanna Kok will serve at 5:00 PM and 10:00 AM Sunday, Hedy McAlister will serve at 1:15 PM Sunday, and Brad Shanklin will serve at 11:45 AM and 6:30 PM Sunday. Please introduce yourself when you see new Lectors and make them feel welcome. The table below shows the name and contact number for the Lector Mass Leaders and the number of active Lectors on the schedule by Mass time. A few Lectors may be scheduled at more than one Mass time.

Lector Procedure Reminder. There are two times during our proclamation of the Word that the Lector procedures call for a pause or period of silence. The first is at the end of the reading, when we are to have a distinct pause. A good way to time this is to silently count “1, 2, 3” and then look up and announce, “The Word of the Lord.” Then, after turning the page, if necessary after Reading 1, or after closing the Lectionary and putting it on the shelf after Reading 2, we are asked to pause for about 10 seconds. A good way to time this is to silently say a Hail Mary. Please be sure to not cut short the brief pause or period of silence.

Easter Masses. We will use online sign-ups for Easter Masses. The Mass schedule for Easter is the same as last year, including five Masses in the Church, one Mass in the new gym at the Faith Formation Center on Spring Creek on the other side of Independence, and three Masses in the Parish Hall in the Parish Activity Center next to the Church. Lectors who are involved with RCIA will be assigned readings at the Saturday evening Easter Vigil. If you wish to serve at a particular Mass for Easter, you may let me know prior to my making the sign-ups available, and I will sign you up.

We are truly blessed to have such a wonderful group of Lectors dedicated to proclaiming the Word of God. I wish everyone a spiritually fulfilling Lent and a Blessed Easter.
