
Summer is almost here, and many Lectors will be taking vacations. Please check the schedule that accompanies this letter, and be sure to find a sub if you will be unable to serve for any assignments during the period June 10–September 3.

New Lectors. We welcome one new Lector on this schedule. Elizabeth Grayson had been a Lector at Seton in the past and has returned to serve at 8:15. Please welcome her back when you see her. The table below shows the name and contact number for the Lector Mass Leaders and the number of active Lectors on the schedule by Mass time. A few Lectors may be scheduled at more than one Mass time. Please let me know if you or someone you know would like to serve at 6:30 PM Sunday.

Lector Procedure Reminder. I've noticed some Lectors stopping at the first pew or slightly closer to the step to bow during the procession. The proper place to stop for the bow is with your toes almost touching the lowest step. After bowing (or bowing just your head if carrying the book), turn to the right to allow the Deacon and Priest to proceed forward while you proceed to your pew. Also, there was some confusion recently about which Lector sits in which pew. We reserve the first two pews on the right of the main aisle for Lectors, but there is no requirement for Lector 1 to sit in the first pew and Lector 2 to sit in the second pew. It is customary to be courteous and allow the Lector with the most guests to use the second pew. If that pew is not long enough for them, a Lector may sit in another pew farther back.

Holy Day Masses. There is one holy day during this schedule period. The Feast of the Assumption, August 15, falls on a Tuesday this year, so there will be a vigil Mass on Monday at 7:00 PM. There will be the usual four Masses for the holy day at 7:00 AM, 8:30 AM, 12:30 PM, and 7:00 PM. The readings are in the *Workbook for Lectors* on pages 224–226 for the vigil Mass and pages 227–230 for the holy day Masses. Please let me know if you would like to volunteer for a reading for one of these Masses.

Enjoy your summer as we take time to enjoy the warmer weather and longer days before diving back into activities for the fall.
