*You are invited to join us for an **ACTS** three-day, three-night retreat*

presented by Catholic lay men and women.

An ACTS retreat allows men and women to focus on his or her faith and its application in daily life, to build purpose in his or her prayer life, to increase their presence at the liturgy and to cultivate friendships with other men and women of faith.

The retreat begins on a Thursday evening with check-in at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish Hall. You are encouraged to bring family members and friends to see you off. Transportation will be provided to and from the retreat center. Spiritual direction will be provided throughout the retreat.

The weekend concludes on Sunday at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton at the 1:15 p.m. Mass. Immediately following the Mass, retreatants will share in food and fellowship with their families and other members of the parish community.

The cost for each retreatant is \$199.00. This covers all meals and lodging. A \$100 registration deposit should be submitted with this form to reserve your place. The remaining balance of \$99 is due on Thursday at Check-in. All faith denominations are welcomed. **Please do not let the cost of the retreat prevent you from participating.**
