*We are still extremely short at 6:30 PM Sunday. Please let me know if you are able to volunteer to serve occasionally at that Mass.*


**Christmas and Other Holy Day Masses.** The Feast of the Immaculate Conception falls on a Saturday this year. There will be a vigil Mass at 7:00 PM on Friday, December 7, and two holy day Masses at 8:30 AM and 11:00 AM on Saturday, December 8.

The Solemnity of Mary Masses include a vigil Mass at 5:00 PM on Monday, December 31, and holy day Masses at 8:15 AM, 10:00 AM, and 11:45 AM on Tuesday, January 1.

We will use online sign-up for those holy day Masses and for all Christmas Eve and Christmas Masses. Please let me know if you would like to volunteer for a reading for one of these Masses, and I can sign you up before I make online sign-ups available.

**New Workbooks.** The new liturgical year starts the first Sunday of Advent, December 1-2. If you have not already done so, pick up one Year C workbook per family in the Lector Room the next time you are at church.
